- Complete the consent form to allow for consultation and planning between the City of Orillia Parks & Recreation and Catulpa Inclusive Recreation Services

Please return the 2 forms listed above to the City of Orillia Parks & Recreation Department by **June 4, 2010**. Requests are dealt with on a first come, first served basis so the sooner the forms are returned, the better your chances of getting your first choice of camp.

Once your completed form is received and reviewed by Parks & Recreation, we will contact you to confirm your camp request and what inclusion services are required. After you receive confirmation of your child's placement, you can register your child in the camp requested and payment of fees will be required. Please note that if you need funding assistance, there is a list of funding resources included in this package.

We look forward to working closely with Nancy Snow, of Catulpa, as we continue to improve our inclusive camp program.
